IF THE COURT HAS REFERRED YOU TO WORK RELEASE:

- Call our office between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M to make an appointment. Leave a message if you get our recording.
- You have 10 working days, after sentencing, to contact us. We ask that you <u>DO</u>
 <u>NOT</u> call the day of your court appearance as we need time to receive the sentencing information (between 2-3 working days).
- We DO NOT transfer cases to other counties or take cases from other counties.
- If you come for an appointment and you are under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs, you will not be accepted into Work Release.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Sentenced in Sonoma County, with a 180 day sentence or less.
- 2. Be physically and mentally able to perform work, and be willing to abide by the program rules.
- 3. *Must not have been arrested for any violent or firearms offenses.
- 4. *Must not have been arrested for a sex offense.
- 5. *Have no arrests for battery against a peace officer.
- 6. Must pay a \$22.00 per day fee, plus a \$90.00 administrative fee. The minimum of \$178 must be brought to your appointment **unless otherwise stated.**The fees are not refundable.
- 7. If you have failed to complete a previous work release sentence and have been removed, you may not be eligible.

If you decide you do not want to participate in the work program, or if you are not accepted into the program, you must report to North County Detention Facility on the date and at the time indicated on your court orders.
