## DUI PROGRAM ORIENTATION AND ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

To enroll in the Driving Under the Influence Program you must first attend an orientation meeting within 21 days of your DUI court sentencing/conviction date. Please note that failure to comply with the 21-day enrollment requirement may result in the court issuing a bench warrant for your arrest. Full program enrollment requires completing a two-step process: first, attending an orientation meeting and then completing an intake appointment.

Orientation and DUI program sign-ups are held on **Wednesday afternoons and Thursday evenings only** (except on County holidays) at 1250 Coddington Center, Room A, following this schedule:

- **WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: DOOR OPENS AT 12:30 P.M. FOR PAPERWORK PROCESSING AND IS CLOSED PROMPTLY AT 1:00 P.M.** Orientation is held between 1:00-2:00 p.m.
- **THURSDAY EVENING: DOOR OPENS AT 4:15 P.M. FOR PAPERWORK PROCESSING AND IS CLOSED PROMPTLY AT 5:00 P.M.** Orientation is held between 5:00-6:00 p.m.

**WE CAN NOT ADMIT YOU AFTER THE DOOR IS CLOSED. EARLY ARRIVAL IS ENCOURAGED.** No appointment is necessary. Program intakes begin immediately after orientation on a first come, first serve basis. *Only the first few people will have intake appointments the same day as orientation-a sign-up list is put out a half-hour before the door opens. The number of intakes conducted is dependent on staff availability. The remaining individuals will schedule an intake appointment for a later date.* **Please note that you are not fully enrolled in a DUI program until you complete an intake appointment. A proof of enrollment certificate, required to obtain a restricted license, will NOT be issued to the DMV until you complete this appointment.**

**To attend an orientation, you must submit the necessary court referral or DMV H-6 paperwork or you will be turned away.** The H-6 should have your DUI arrest and BAC information printed on the form. The H-6 is available at any local DMV branch office. **MINIMUM PROGRAM DOWN PAYMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CLIENTS AT INTAKE.** For those receiving intake appointments, you must bring the minimum down payment to the appointment or we cannot enroll you.

Minimum program down payments:

- \$167. – Wet Reckless (6 weeks); \$334. program cost
- \$200. – 3 Month FOP (First Offender); \$562. program cost
- \$264. – 9 Month EXT (extended First Offender: BAC .20 or above, or a refusal); \$968. program cost
- \$340. – 18 Month MOP (Multiple Offender): \$1,645. program cost
