DUI COURT ORDERS/CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

G1.....No legal cause why judgment should not be pronounced. Imposition of sentence suspended.

G5AFORMAL PROBATION granted for 60 months (5 YEARS)

Note: Initially and during the term of active DUI Court participation, probation supervision will be Formal. You may request the Court to convert probation status to Informal at any time during participation or upon graduation from the program.

M.....Defendant to serve _____ 120 days in Sonoma County Jail with 1 day credit for each successful week and 2 days credit for each successful phase of the program; balance may be served on SEC (Supervised Electronic Confinement) during the term of probation and is stayed until further Court order

D31E.....Defendant is accepted to participate in the **DUI Court Program**

H14.....Be of good conduct and obey all laws

H18.....Submit to warrantless search & seizure of person, property, vehicle any time of the day or night

H18C.....or residence any time of the day or reasonable hour of the night by any Probation or Law Enforcement officer or DUI Court Representative

H19B....Submit to random chemical tests as directed by Probation or Law Enforcement Officer or drug counselor

H20.....Do not possess or use any alcohol

H21.....Do not possess or use any controlled substances or associated paraphernalia without valid prescription

H22.....Do not own, possess, or use any firearms **H23.....**weapons [A].....ammunition

H25.....Stay out of places where alcohol is the primary item of sale

H26A...Do not drive with any alcohol, drugs, or intoxicating substances in your system

H27.....Do not drive without a valid California license & insurance in effect

H28.....First Offender Drinking Driver Program referral [C].....9mo extended program

H31..... Multiple Offender Drinking Driver Program referral

H30.....Enroll within 21 days & complete as directed

H38A...You will be designated a **Habitual Traffic Offender** by DMV (3rd or subsequent offense)

H38.....DL-309 Habitual Traffic Offender (form to be completed by clerk)

J18.....Total fine of \$ _____ (includes assessments and \$20 Security Fee)

J8.....\$ _____ Restitution fine per 1202.4(b) of the Penal Code

J15A....\$ _____ Restitution fine per 1202.44 PC, suspended unless probation is revoked

U28.....All fines, fees, and restitution to be paid to Probation as directed by Probation Officer

D47.....You will not graduate from the DUI Court until all fees, fines, and restitution have been paid.

D48.....Complete a diagnostic evaluation as directed.

D49.....Complete all objectives of your Counseling Treatment Plan.

D50.....Cooperate with your probation officer in any plan for psychological, psychiatric, alcohol and/or drug treatment

- D51.....Make all counseling sessions, court appearances, driving programs, AA meetings (or other self-help meetings) as directed.
- D52.....Obey all laws, orders, rules, & regulations of Probation Dept, Court, Sonoma County Alcohol & Drug Services, & Jail.
- D53.....Attend, complete and provide proof of a Court approved Victim Impact Panel
- D54.....If involved in a collision, pay restitution to the victim as directed by Probation.
- D55.....Pursuant to VC 13352 your driving privilege: (1 prior) is suspended for 2 years subject to the right
- D56.....to apply to DMV for a restricted license when you comply with VC 13352 BS 13352.5; or (2 priors) is revoked for 3 years.
- D57.....Use your true name & true DOB in dealing with DMV, the Court & Law Enforcement.
- D57A...Do not apply for a driver's license in any other state or with any other name without disclosing
- D57B...this conviction & any suspension or restriction caused by this conviction.
- D58.....Comply with the DUI Court plea agreement & the directions of the Sonoma County Alcohol &
- D58A...Drugs Services & its employees & the Sonoma County Probation Department & its employees.

- D60.....You are hereby advised that being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both, impairs your
- D60A... ability to safely operate a motor vehicle. Therefore, it is extremely dangerous to human life to
- D60B....drive while under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both. If you continue to drive while under
- D60C....the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both, and as a result of that driving someone is killed, you can be charged with murder.
